

**OUACHITA CHRISTIAN SCHOOL
EXTRACURRICULAR DISCIPLINE POLICY**

It is the philosophy of the board, administration and staff of Ouachita Christian School that participation in extracurricular activities at OCS is a special privilege and carries an added responsibility of representing the school in a very unique way. In keeping with this philosophy we adhere to the following policy.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:

- (1) If a participant partakes of alcoholic beverages out-of-season he/she will be disciplined with extra conditioning, etc., as deemed necessary by the coaches involved for a period for not less than 20% of the off-season.

If a second incident occurs during the same off-season the student will be suspended from all extracurricular activities for one calendar year.

- (2) If the drinking occurs during season he/she will be suspended, immediately following the incident, a number of games equal to 20% of the regular season.

If a second offense occurs in-season, the offense will result in suspension from all extracurricular activities for one calendar year.

MOOD ALTERING DRUGS

The use of mood altering drugs, regardless of the time of year, will result in automatic suspension for one calendar year. Before returning the participant must pass a drug test and be subject to regular testing (as determined by the Administration) at the parent's expense.

PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING

In the case of any of the above violations the student may be asked to undergo professional counseling, at the parent's expense, in order to remain a student at OCS.

AGREEMENT

Each school year a copy of this agreement shall be signed by each individual involved in extracurricular activities.

It is not our desire to destroy young people who fall victim to peer pressure but to assist them in becoming more like Christ. Obviously, these are very difficult decisions and it is our hope that these guidelines will help.
